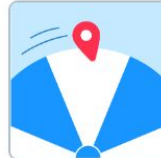
Match up

Flip tiles

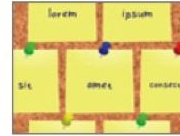
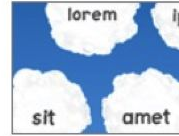
Explore a series of two sided tiles by tapping to zoom and swiping to flip.

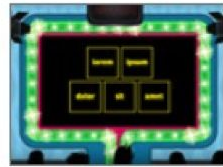
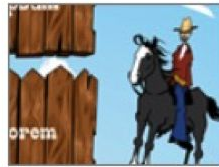

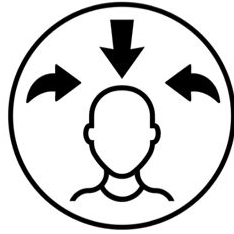

Standard 1: Interpretive Communication



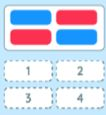
Learners understand, interpret, and analyze what is heard, read, received, or viewed on a variety of topics, using a range of diverse texts, including authentic resources.

A series of multiple choice questions. Tap the correct answer to proceed.



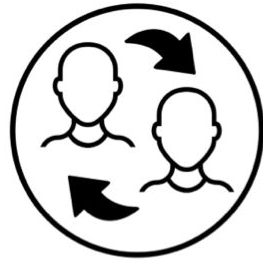
Rank order

Standard 2: Interpersonal Communication




Learners interact and negotiate meaning in spoken, visual, or written conversations to exchange information and express feelings, preferences, and opinions.

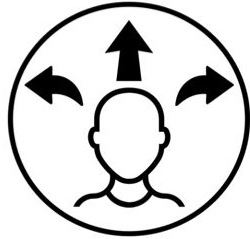

Standard 3: Presentational Communication




Learners present information and ideas on a variety of topics adapted to various audiences of listeners, readers or viewers to describe, inform, narrate, explain, or persuade.

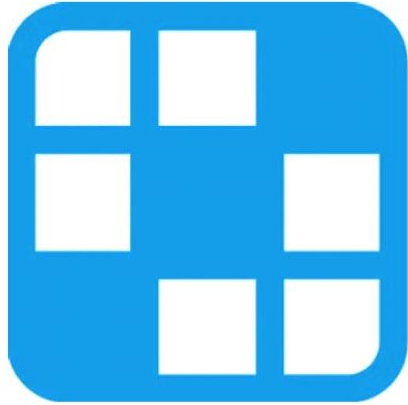
