Photos of project not acceptable!*
- Students may work individually or in groups to create a visual art such as video or skit. Maximum number of students in the group is 4. Spelling is VERY IMPORTANT!*
- Please include the item with this submission form and return by March 21, 2015 (it may be turned in at the Regional Conference). The winner will receive a check for \$100 (to be split if there is a group). The winning school and nominating teacher will be notified.*
- Student(s) may not use any material that is copyrighted. A translator may NOT be used for sentences, sections or the entire project.*
